4. Once you have created your account or signed in, you will have access to your *My zyBooks library*. You will see one zyBook, called “How to use zyBooks” in your library.

Below your library is a field where you should enter the class code that your instructor provided. It is best to copy-paste (class code is case sensitive). Once the code is entered, click “Find zyBook.”

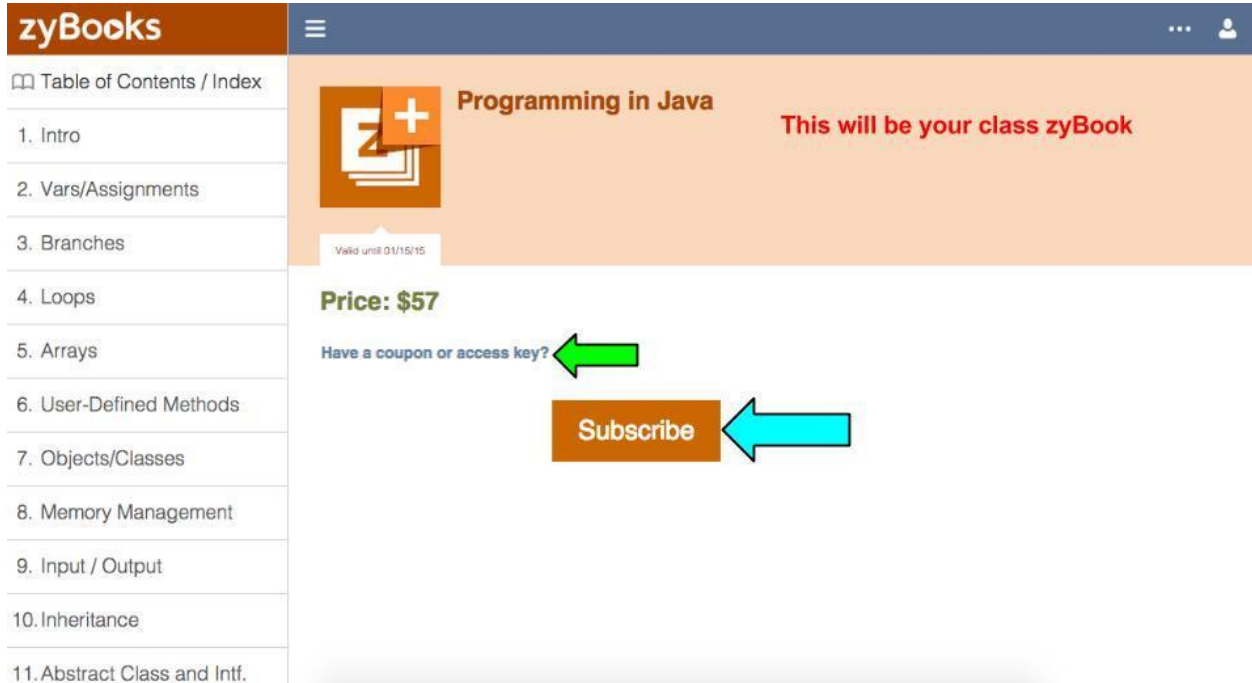
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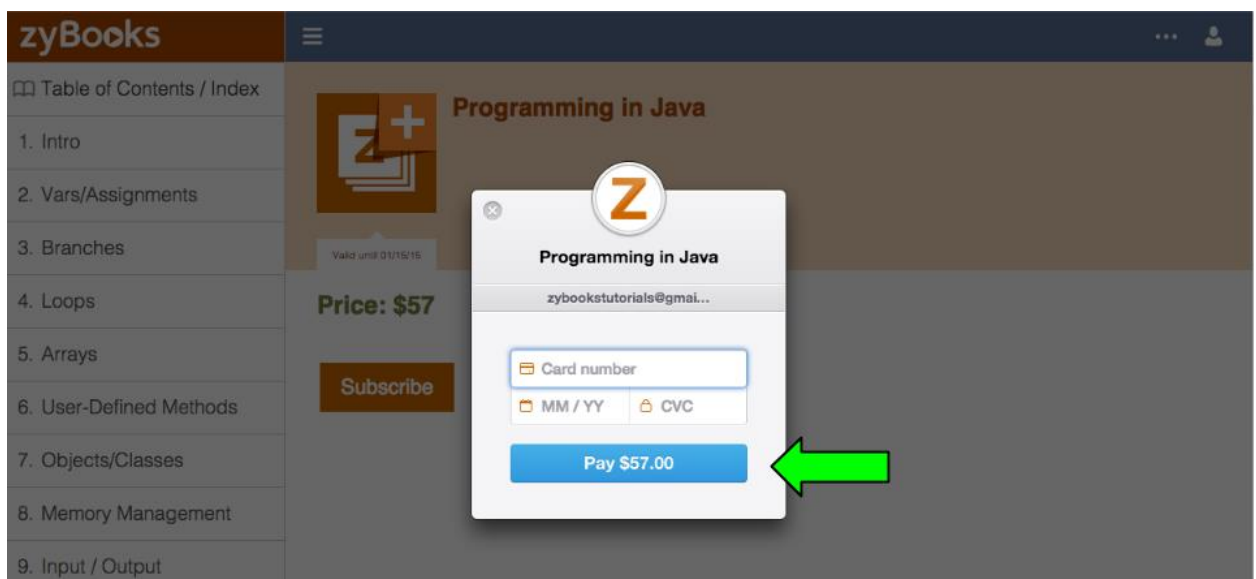

5. This will bring you to your class zyBook. The first chapter and Table of Contents are freely available. Click the “Subscribe” button to gain full access to the zyBook. If you possess an access key, click the link that is just above the “Subscribe” button called “Have a coupon or access key?” Please note that if you purchased an access key from the bookstore, the price may differ from the posted price.



6. This will prompt for payment. Enter your information and click the “Pay” button.



7. After payment or entering your access code, your class zyBook will be added to your library. To access it again, simply go to your library on zybooks.com and click the class zyBook.
