He is well behind in the course, and did not take the first of two prelim exams. On March 4, before the first exam, he fell and incurred a bad wrist sprain, for which he has been treated. He has however been having a second difficulty, for which he has been advised to consult a neurologist or a neuropsychologist. In my opinion this second problem is largely responsible for his inability to complete the coursework—his last substantial submitted work was at the end of February. I recommend that he receive due attention for a thorough diagnosis, and depending on results, than an Administrative Withdrawal be granted for my course in this current term.
